- The completed application form
- Current C.V. (a 2 x 2 in photo optional)
- Copy of your California Driver's License
- Sealed official school transcripts
- A personal statement, not limiting to your short and long term goals and ways that you would like to contribute to the Vietnamese community. Please keep your essay between 500 to 700 typed words.
- Deadline: Applications are accepted till December 31, 2021.

Eligibility:

- Applicant must be of Vietnamese descendant
- Applicant must have permanent resident status in Northern California (prior to school admission or during attendance)
- Attending one of the accredited colleges and universities
- Completed the 1st year of undergraduate college
- Must be able to attend the Scholarship Award seminar in January
